The Pre-Tribulation Rapture Theory Helps Bible

This special version of the Bible is a sort of prototype Bible designed to help those who want to believe that the church will be caught up to heaven to be with Jesus before the great tribulation begins. Ordinary Bibles do not contain verses that support this theory, so we have created this paper to show what a parallel Bible would look like if it had a normal Bible in one column and a special pre-tribulation rapture version in the other column. Since Bible students have a difficult time finding verses in the Bible that speak to a pre-tribulation rapture, here we include the ideas that one can bring to the text to make the text say what you want the Bible to say as a pre-tribulation rapture believer.

Below are two columns. The column on the left contains a special Bible version with the text modified so that it is easier for you to believe that there will be a pre-tribulation rapture of the church so that Christians will be spared the kinds of suffering that God's prophets went through, that Jesus' apostles went through, and that believers in many places all over the world have suffered for the past 2000 years.

The column on the right contains Bible verses which have not been molested so that you can see how unreliable normal Bibles are compared with a special pre-tribulation rapture Bible. In the column on the left some words are highlighted in yellow. These are words that should have been added by the Bible authors to make it clear what the text really means. There are also some words that have lines drawn through them so we can see which words God made a mistake on when he inspired the Bible

Pre-Trib / Dispensational Paraphrase (the corrected Bible)
